

RECLAIMED FLOORING

This is an opportunity to truly own a piece of history. Salvaged from the attics of beautiful historic homes, our reclaimed flooring is a masterpiece of what 200 years of aging can produce in a floor. As with Weatherboard flooring we leave the original surface untouched. Each floor has a story of its own.

Sawn from beams 150 to 200 years old. Thickness: 3/4 inch to 2-1/2 inches Widths: 6 inches to 13 inches Lengths: 4 feet to 16 feet, average 12 feet

Widths: 6 inches by 6 inches to 12 inches by 12 inches
Lengths: 6 feet to 40 feet
Mostly Oak and White Pine removed from barns
built between 1750 and 1850.

Also available are floor joist, roof rafters, and logs for log homes.







Weather Board Flooring/Paneling

Beautiful light and dark brown tones with original saw marks strewn across each unique board make this flooring one of our most popular. Produced from the inside panel of barn siding, we leave the surface untouched so that the beautiful patina can speak for itself!

Widths: 4 inches to 10 inches






RESAWN WHITE PINE

Different from our other floors, white pine distinguishes itself with its beautiful clear grain. This floor's warm golden glow is offset by its rustic brown knots. Resawn white pine is a wonderful choice for any home.

Widths: 4 inches to 10 inches






Resawn Oak

Our oak is resawn from 200 year old barn beams and has a stunning mixture of warm brown tones. Characterized by beautiful old worm trails and check marks, your oak flooring will be admired by all.

Wide Widths: 6 inches to 10 inches Narrow Widths: 3, 4 and 5 inches






RESAWN HEART PINE

A slightly more formal looking floor, our heart pine is cut from large, antique beams that have been rescued from demolition. With beautiful rustic red and golden hues, the tight and varied grain of our heart pine flooring is certainly breathtaking.

Resawn Chestnut

This commercially extinct flooring is known for its unique grain pattern and warm color. Popularly known as "wormy chestnut", the blight of the late 1800's has given our chestnut flooring beautiful character along with tiny "worm" markings. Anyone viewing your chestnut flooring will be certain that you own a piece of history!

Widths: 3 inches to 8 inches
